### TRACEY WRIGHT - CHAIR OF GOVERNORS



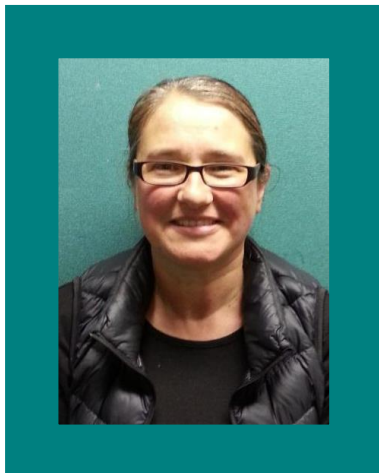
As a Governing Body we work with the Leadership Group and key members of staff in understanding and monitoring the school priority areas.
