European Day of Languages

Next Tuesday, 26th September, is European Languages Day. Traditionally the school has celebrated our own "International Languages Day" on this day to celebrate some of the cultures and languages represented in our school community.

The classes each choose a country from around the world and the children enjoy a day of different activities to celebrate the culture and learn a little of the language. The children may come to school dressed in any combination of colours from the flag of their class country if they wish (however, please don't buy any new clothes - close colours, or a white PE t-shirt with a flag sticker will also be perfectly acceptable). Children can choose to come to school in their usual uniform, if they prefer.

This year the chosen countries are:

- Nursery (Ladybirds): France (red, white and blue flag)
- Reception (Butterflies and Bees): Spain (red and yellow flag)
- Year 1 (Wagtails and Squirrels): Poland (red and white flag)
- Year 2 (Ravens and Foxes): Poland (red and white flag)
- Year 3 (Woodpeckers and Robins): Italy (green, white and red flag)
- Year 4 (Fireflies and Merlins): Greece (blue and white flag)
- Year 5 (Falcons and Crickets): Sweden (blue and yellow flag)
- Year 6 (Stoats and Skylarks): China (red and yellow flag)
