We have also been working hard on our fine motor skills, threading straws, wood and pipe cleaners, tricky but fun!





In maths, they have continued to learn about subtraction using manipulatives. The children have also looked at their carnival floats and have been evaluating them by considering what went well and what they would like to improve on next time.

This week in **Fireflies** we have begun our learning all about non-chronological reports. We have looked at what makes a good one, how to use subheadings and when we should move on to a new paragraph in our writing – ask us about the paragraph song! We have also learnt some new vocabulary in science which will help us with our learning about shadows – translucent, transparent and opaque. In DT we

have developed our skills of cutting, scoring and investigated how to strengthen materials.


