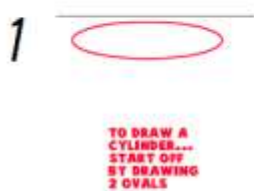

Art Start of the Day

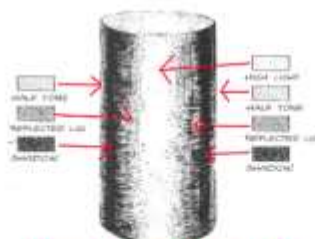
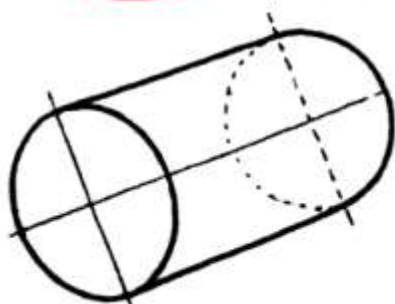
