Dear Parents,

This week we looked at another painting where we tried to find objects in the painting. The painting was by Paul Saul and called 'View of San Francisco, Number 2'

His work has connections with Pop Art, Surrealism, and Expressionism. His early use of pop culture cartoon references in the late 1950s and very early 1960s situates him as one of the fathers of the Pop Art movement. He realised about 800 paintings during his career.

We asked the children to find the following:-
6 ships, 3 palm trees, 3 bridges, 1 wiggly road,
1 tunnel, 3 pagodas, 1 doughnut-shaped building
and the number 76 twice.
