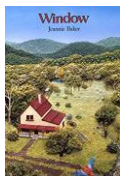


Curriculum Information Term 3 Moles, Robins and Pine Martens

English

We will share Jeannie Baker's "Window"



In our writing we will be learning to:

- Use descriptive words and extend our sentences with words such as and, with and because.
- Write a simple diary.
- Write a fictional description based on the book "Window".
- Write a simple letter.

Maths

We will be learning to:

- Read and write numbers to 20.
- Add and subtract to 20 and record as equations.
- Recognise and name 2D and 3D shapes.

Spelling/Phonics

Children will be learning and applying phonic knowledge in their writing and reading.

Children will learn Year 1 common exception words, and will practise and be tested in school weekly.



School Days

This term we will be learning about our school and locality, both as it is today and how it was when the school opened. To find out more we will meet Bev Kenyon via Zoom! She was the Mead's first Deputy Head, currently living on the beautiful island of Crete. We will learn about schools in Victorian times and how they compare with school life today. We will research Victorian school life and artefacts. We will find out more about **Samuel Wilderspin** and how his beliefs helped to bring play and outdoor play spaces to schools.

History

We will find out more about our school when it was first built. We will find out what it was like to be pupils and teachers in the Victorian times. We will compare Victorian school artefacts with items we use today. Our role play area will be a Victorian school.

Art

We will look at artwork depicting streets and buildings. We will focus on the work of American pop artist, **James Rizzi**. We will create a mural based on his work.



Geography

We will use Google Earth to explore the school locality. We will draw simple maps of our local area. We will think about how we can reduce litter.

Music

We will be exploring how to make long and short sounds vocally and on instruments. We will be listening to Gamelan music from Indonesia.

PE

We will develop our throwing, catching and bouncing skills. We will practise throwing and catching with two hands. We will develop leadership skills by demonstrating our ideas to others.

PHSE

We will think about how our bodies grow and change.

We will use iPads and cameras to capture pictures of school life.
