English

We will be reading *Secrets of a Sun King* by Emma Carroll as our class text.



We will be writing:

- A diary in response to the text
- A personal recount
- A balanced argument



Ancient Civilisations

This project teaches children about the history of three of the world's first ancient civilisations: ancient Sumer, ancient Egypt and the Indus Valley civilisation. Children will learn about the rise, life, achievements and eventual end of each civilisation.

Computing

In computing, we will look at the difference between count-controlled and infinite loops, and use our knowledge to modify existing animations and games using repetition. Our final project is to design and create a game which uses repetition, applying stages of programming design throughout.
