English

We will be reading Malala's Magic Pencil



In our writing we will be learning to:

Write a newspaper report on the moon landings.

Write a personal biography.

Write a narrative based on Malala's big pencil.



Movers and Shakers

This project teaches children about historically significant people who have had a major impact on the world. They will learn to use timelines, stories and historical sources to find out about the people featured and use historical models to explore their significance.

Maths

We will be concentrating on various aspects of numbers to 100. We will be comparing numbers using our place value knowledge. We will go through our number bonds and explore number patterns within 100.

Spelling/Phonics

We will be introducing homophones, such as whole, hole, knight and night.

We will be teaching techniques to help the children learn spellings such as look, say, cover, write, check.
