

English

We will be reading **The Paper Dolls** by Julia Donaldson, **Grandad's Island** by Benji Davies and **Wilfred Gordon McDonald Partridge** by Mem Fox.



In our writing we will:

- Write simple riddles
- Write our own stories based on **Grandad's Island**, by Benji Davies
- Write a short autobiography

Maths - We will be learning to:

- Multiply numbers together by making and adding groups
- Double numbers up to double 10
- Divide numbers by sharing
- Find halves and quarters of shapes and numbers
- Explore place value to 40

Spelling/Phonics

We will be learning and applying phonic knowledge in both writing and reading.

We will continue to learn Year 1 common exception words, and will practise each week during our Friday phonics session.



Childhood – All About Me!

Through this project we will explore everyday life and families today, and will compare our experiences with childhood in the 1950s, using artefacts and a range of different sources.

We will connect virtually with David Birks from **Trowbridge Museum**. He will share images and artefacts relating to homes, toys and schools in the 1950s.



History

Children will be able to compare artefacts from the 1950s to those we use in the present day. They will use sequencing words, such as first, next, finally, then and after that, to help to put information and photographs into chronological order.

Art and Design

In our companion project '**Funny Faces and Fabulous Features**' children will learn about the concept of the portrait and how different techniques can be used to make a portrait.

Science

We will identify, name, draw and label the basic parts of the human body. We will learn more about our senses, saying which part of the body is associated with each sense. We will investigate using our senses.



Music

We will be playing rhythms from different songs using body percussion and untuned percussion. We will be learning about the difference between pulse and rhythm by playing songs in two parts. We will be listening to and learning childhood songs from around the world.

PE

We will continue to work on fundamental movement skills, as well as how to strike a ball using a hockey stick.

PSHE

We will have the Virtual Life Bus experience to teach us about our bodies and ways to keep healthy. We will learn about growing and changing from young to old and how people's needs change.
