


English

Science

In science, we will be observing and describing how seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants. We will also find out what plants need to grow and stay healthy.

Art/DT

In art, we will be looking at the work of Georgia O Keefe to inspire our own observational drawings.

Geography

In geography, we will be drawing sketch maps that include symbols and a key. We will also be finding out about different climates around the world and what plants grow there.

PE

The children will learn to stop and strike a moving ball with sporting equipment such as a hockey stick. They will also master basic fundamental movement skills including running and jumping, agility and coordination. Children will focus on the personal skill of resilience in their P.E. lessons and begin to apply these skills in a range of activities and competitive sports.

Music

We will be learning how to read rhythm notation onto untuned percussion instruments, and composing our own 4 bar rhythm pieces as a class and in groups. We will be learning to sing the pitches "soh, mi, lah" and use hand signs. We will be listening to music that is inspired by nature.
