Dear Mead Families,

Our first week ended with the news of the passing of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II. We came together as a school on Friday morning to share this news and take time to show our respects. The following words were shared with pupils and staff:

"Yesterday was a very sad day in the history of our country – Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II died peacefully at the age of 96, surrounded by her family at one of her favourite homes, Balmoral Castle in Scotland.

We have come together this morning for a moment of reflection which is our part in beginning a period of national mourning – when we remember the life of Elizabeth II. This starts today across the whole country and will last for around ten days.

Foe everyone in this hall, Queen Elizabeth is the only queen we have known. She has been your queen, the queen of your parents, your grandparents, great grandparents and even great-great grandparents, all the way back to 1952, which was 70 years ago.

You will remember in the summer how we celebrated the Platinum Jubilee. Elizabeth II was the longest serving monarch – a king or queen – this country has ever had.

Throughout her reign as our Queen, Elizabeth always did her duty to serve her country. Loved and respected by people of all backgrounds and beliefs, across our country of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, and the Commonwealth of countries for whom she was also Queen, Elizabeth II always had the ability to be calm, thoughtful, kind and true to her role.

Over the next week there will be events in the country to remember her, leading up to her funeral, probably in the week after next. Things will feel different in that time. This is a historic moment. It is the end of the second Elizabethan age, the longest reign in British history. Elizabeth's eldest son, Charles, is now the King. He is King Charles III.

Throughout seventy years of change, from shortly after the Second World war to the present day, our Queen was strong and kind and calm – respected because, like a loving mother and grandmother for the nation, she always cared about her people and knew her duty was to be the best of us.

Thank you, ma'am, for all that you gave to our country, you will be loved and remembered forever, and God Save The King."

The school's Union flag will remain at half-mast throughout this period of mourning. Like all schools, we will be closed on Monday 19th September to respect The Queen's funeral.
