Reporting Covid-19 symptoms to the school

If you or anyone in your family is showing Covid symptoms, is being tested or has received a positive Covid-19 test please inform the school as soon as possible by emailing <u>covidreporting@themead.wilts.sch.uk</u> (including over the weekend and during school holidays).

Illness reporting to the school

Please be reminded that should your child have sickness or diarrhoea they must remain at home for 48 hours after their last bout to ensure the bug has properly cleared.

We also request that if your child has a temperature they must remain at home for at least the following 24 hours of their temperature returning to normal (without being medicated), again, to ensure that the bug has cleared.

Dear Mead families

As we enter the last week of term, it is noticeable that school attendance has recovered dramatically from the Covid situation that was affecting all classes in January. We're at the mid-point of the school year now and our current whole school attendance is 94%, slightly higher than the current national average for primary schools which has risen from 89% to 92%. These figures show the impact of Covid, as normally we would expect our attendance to be around 97%.

In the second half of the school year, which will hopefully be relatively free from Covid, we will be monitoring attendance even more rigorously than normal in order to ensure that, wherever possible, there is no more missed school.

Across a school year each day of absence is 0.5% (1% at this half-way stage); all attendance can therefore recover and our aim is to have every child above 95% except in authorised medical circumstances. We also need to ensure that every child is in school by gate closure at 08:50am so that no learning is missed at the start of the school day.

Thank you for your support as we drive the school recovery from the pandemic.
