Dear Mead families,

As Term 3 ends, we reach the mid-way point of the school year. This is always a good time to reflect on where we are at, and one headline to share is our excellent attendance data. The school is significantly above national average for attendance in the first half of this year – really strong in the autumn, hit by lots of bugs and viruses before Christmas then recovering again this term. I share this because good attendance always tells us that the essential triangle – school, pupils and parents – is working so well. Thank you.

It has been a very productive Term 3 and I am proud of the progress and attainment being made. Yesterday, Mrs Seviour reported to our governance team – the Academy Advisory Group (AAG) – about all aspects of inclusion and support for pupils, and it was deeply reassuring to look at the forensic detail around our children, held so well by Mrs Seviour and reflective of excellent home-school communication. From detailed statutory plans to light touch support, it is always essential that we see every child as an individual in our team and provide the support they need. This concept was presented beautifully to the children on Monday by Mrs Baber, who led an assembly on equity.

Each Monday we lead on FREDICE values in assembly; these are the Olympic and Paralympic values of Friendship, Respect, Equality (equity), Determination, Inspiration, Courage and Excellence. Next term we are going to build on this term's focus of 'respect', 'friendship' and 'equality', by looking at 'determination', 'courage' and 'excellence' in all that we do. We hope that the children talk excitedly with you about this learning.

Finally, reports are now being written for distribution later next month. This will be followed by Parent Conversations Week from 24th April. It will be lovely to share your child's progress with you.
